Health information is treated as special category personal data under UK GDPR and receives additional protection.

We may collect:

- IP address
- Device information

- Website usage information
- Pages visited and interactions with our website

This information may be collected through cookies and analytics tools.

- Information you voluntarily provide to us

Some of the information we collect may relate to your health or wellbeing.

We process health information using your explicit consent and take additional steps to safeguard this information.

You may withdraw your consent at any time, although this may affect our ability to provide certain services.

Who We Share Information With

We do not sell your personal information.

We may share information with trusted service providers who help us operate our business.

These may include:

These organisations are only permitted to process information on our behalf and under our instructions.

We may also disclose information where required by law.

International Transfers

Some of our service providers may process personal information outside the United Kingdom.

Where this occurs, we ensure appropriate safeguards are in place to protect your information, including approved contractual protections or reliance on adequacy regulations where applicable.

Data Retention

We keep personal information only for as long as necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

Generally:

- Marketing information is retained until you unsubscribe or withdraw consent.
- Client records are retained for as long as necessary to provide services and comply with legal obligations.
- Financial records are retained in accordance with UK tax and accounting requirements.
- Health information is retained only for as long as necessary to provide services safely and effectively, unless a longer retention period is required by law.

When information is no longer required, it is securely deleted or anonymised.

Data Security

We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your information against unauthorised access, loss, misuse, alteration or disclosure.

While no method of transmission over the internet is completely secure, we take reasonable steps to safeguard your information.

Your Rights

Under UK data protection law, you have the right to:

- Access your personal information
- Request correction of inaccurate information

- Request deletion of your information
- Request restriction of processing
- Object to processing
- Request transfer of your information to another organisation in certain circumstances
- Withdraw consent where consent is the lawful basis for processing
